AARP DRIVER SAFETY COURSE OFFERED

Commission on Aging will again host the AARP Smart Driver Course™. AARP Driver Safety is the nation's first and largest refresher course designed specifically for drivers aged 50 and older.

Classroom instruction is scheduled for May 23th and 24th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. This is a two-day class and participants must attend both days to receive a certificate. Classes will take place in the lower conference room of the Grand Traverse County Commission on Aging. There is a fee of \$15 for AARP members and \$20 for non-AARP members to take the course, payable to the instructor.

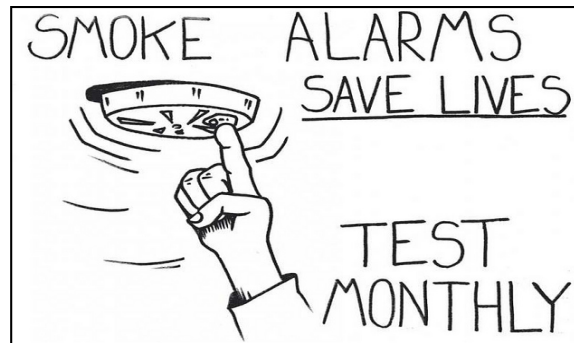


The Commission on Aging will be closed Friday, April 19th in observance of the Easter Holiday. Let your worker know if you need your appointment to be made up this day.
