**NOTICE OF DAY OF REVIEW OF DRAINAGE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES
AND DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS**

OLD MISSION DRAIN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Grand Traverse County Drain Commissioner will be holding a Day of Review for the Old Mission Drain Drainage District on **Friday, October 25, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Peninsula Township Hall, 13235 Center Road, Traverse City, 49686** to review the proposed Drainage District boundaries and tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District and to hear any objections to the project costs associated with the establishment and maintenance of the Old Mission Peninsula Drain and the assessment roll.

The Drain Commissioner will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner of their County at (231) 922-4807 (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Grand Traverse County Circuit Court with ten (10) days, and you may also appeal the Drain Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Grand Traverse County Probate Court within ten (10) days.

If you would like to view or receive a copy of the drainage district boundaries, project costs, or the assessment roll, you may contact the Grand Traverse County Drain Commissioner at the phone number or email address listed above.
